**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION AND ACKNOWLEDGMENT AND DELIVERY BY THE COUNTY OF ESSEX OF CERTAIN AGREEMENTS IN RELATION TO COUNTY GUARANTEED LEASE REVENUE PROJECT NOTES/BONDS, SERIES 202[\_] (ESSEX COUNTY ELECTION STORAGE AND TRANSPORTATION BUILDING PROJECT) OF THE ESSEX COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY**

**SUMMARY**

The foregoing titled ordinance (the “Ordinance”) approves the financing of the construction and equipping of a new County of Essex (the “County”) Election Storage and Transportation building located at 39 Commerce Court, Verona, New Jersey with the proceeds of the Authority’s proposed issuance of “County Guaranteed Lease Revenue Project Notes/Bonds, Series 202[\_] (Essex County Election Storage and Transportation Building Project)” (the “Bonds”) in an amount not to exceed \$40,000,000. The Ordinance further authorizes the President and Vice President of the Board of County Commissioners, County Administrator, Director of Finance, Treasurer or such other officer of the County (each, an “Authorized Officer”), upon the satisfaction of all the legal conditions precedent to the execution, acknowledgment and delivery by the County of the Financing Documents as defined in the Ordinance (the “Agreements”), to execute, acknowledge and deliver the Agreements. The Ordinance further authorizes the performance of any act, the execution or acknowledgement and delivery of any other document, instrument or closing certificates which the Authorized Officer deems necessary, desirable or convenient in connection with the contemplated transaction.

**STATEMENT**

The ordinance published herewith has been finally adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Essex, New Jersey, State of New Jersey on August 12, 2026 and the 20-day period of limitation within which a suit, action or proceeding questioning the validity of such ordinance can be commenced, as provided in the Local Bond Law has begun to run from the date of the first publication of this statement. Copies of the full ordinance will be available at no cost and during regular business hours, at the Clerk’s office for the members of the general public who shall request the same.
